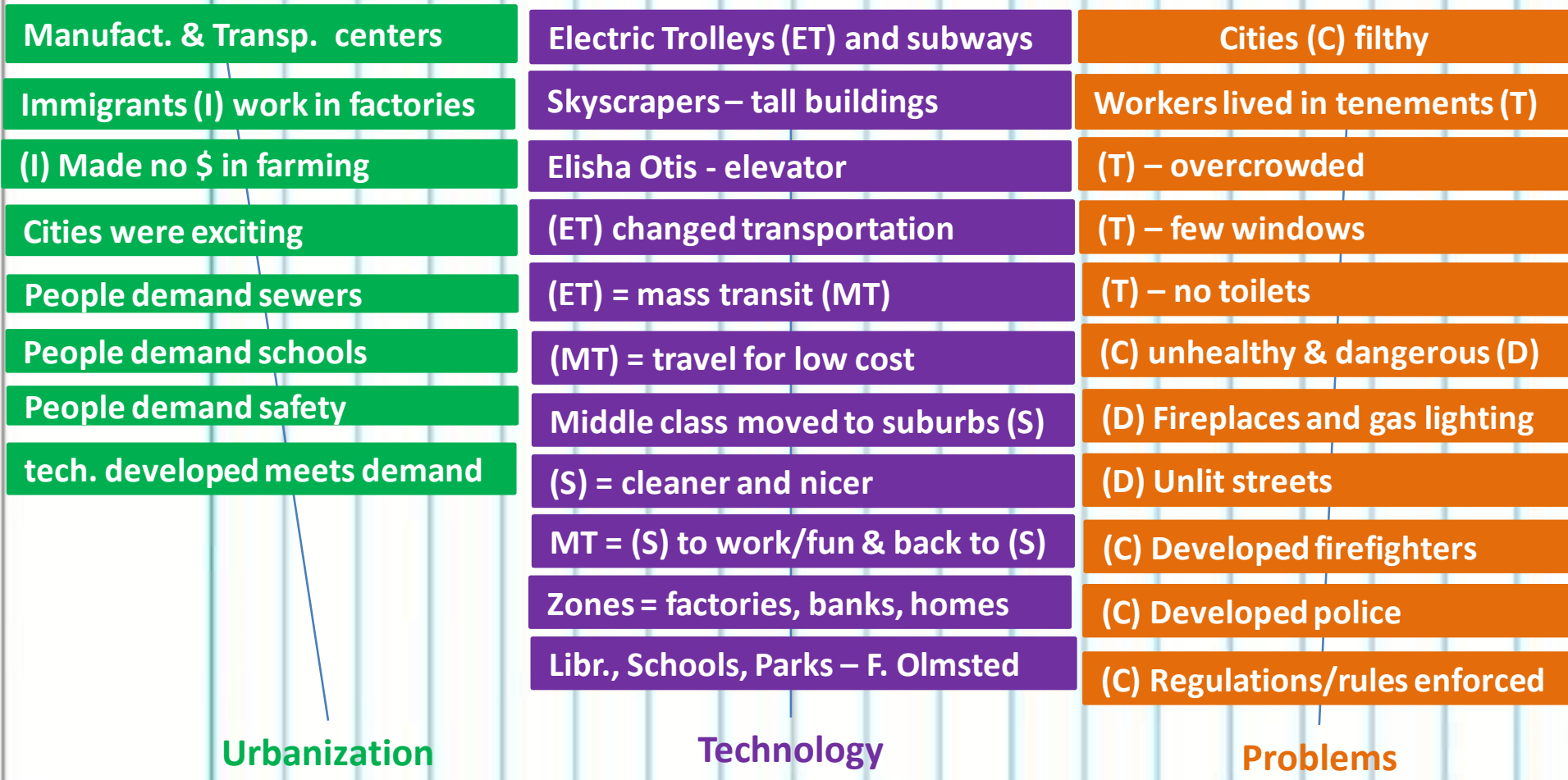

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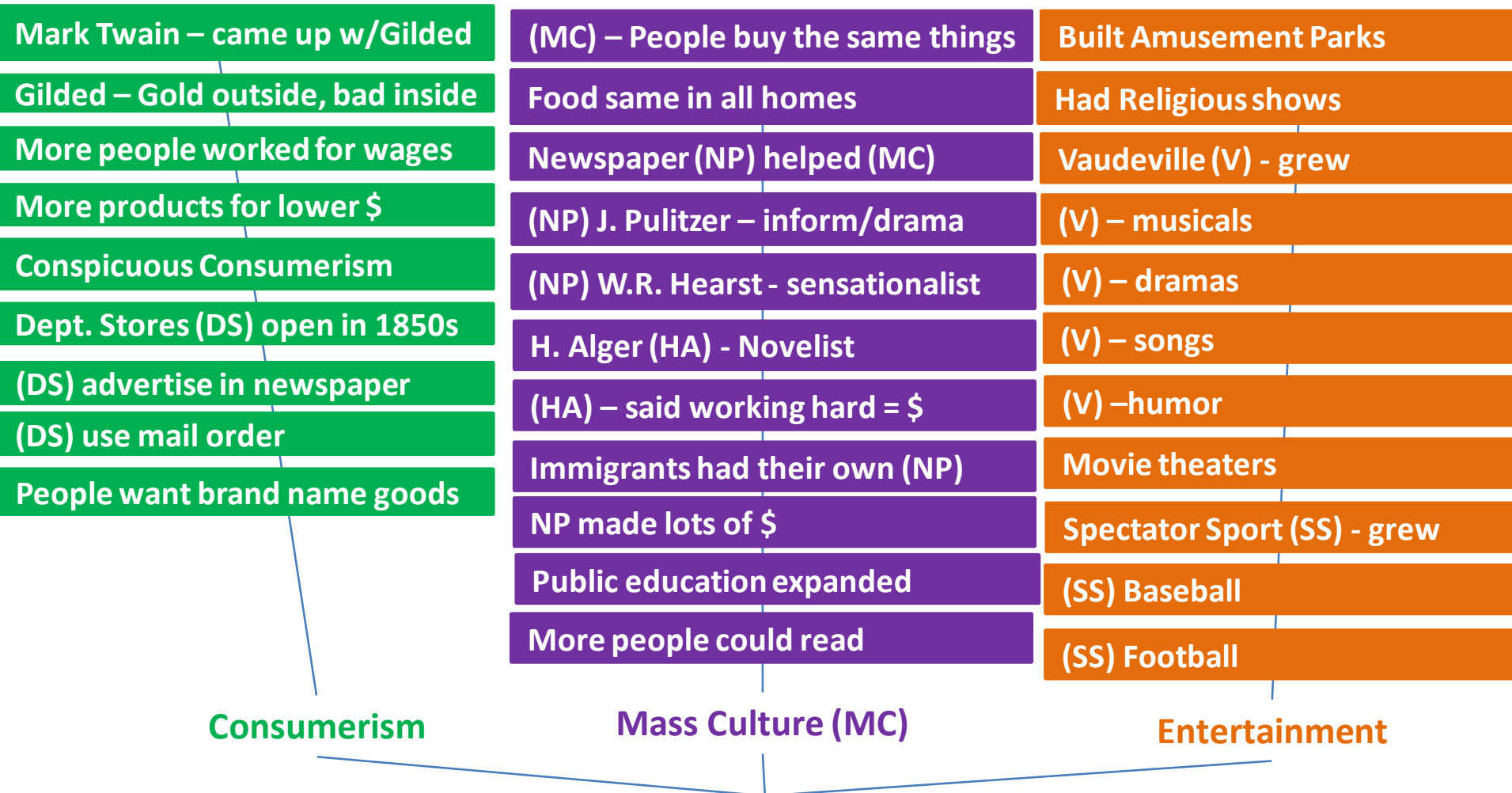

Dems. nor Rep. kept control long
Hard to pass new laws
Presidents were weak
Inaction was common

Spoils System (SS) common
(SS) – Gov't jobs given for loyalty
(SS) – Gov't traded jobs for votes
Pre. Garfield – reform Civil Service
Pre. Garfield – job based on skills
Pre. Garfield killed by angry voter
Pendleton Civil Service Act signed
Had to take exam to get gov't job

Rep. wanted high tariffs (HT)
