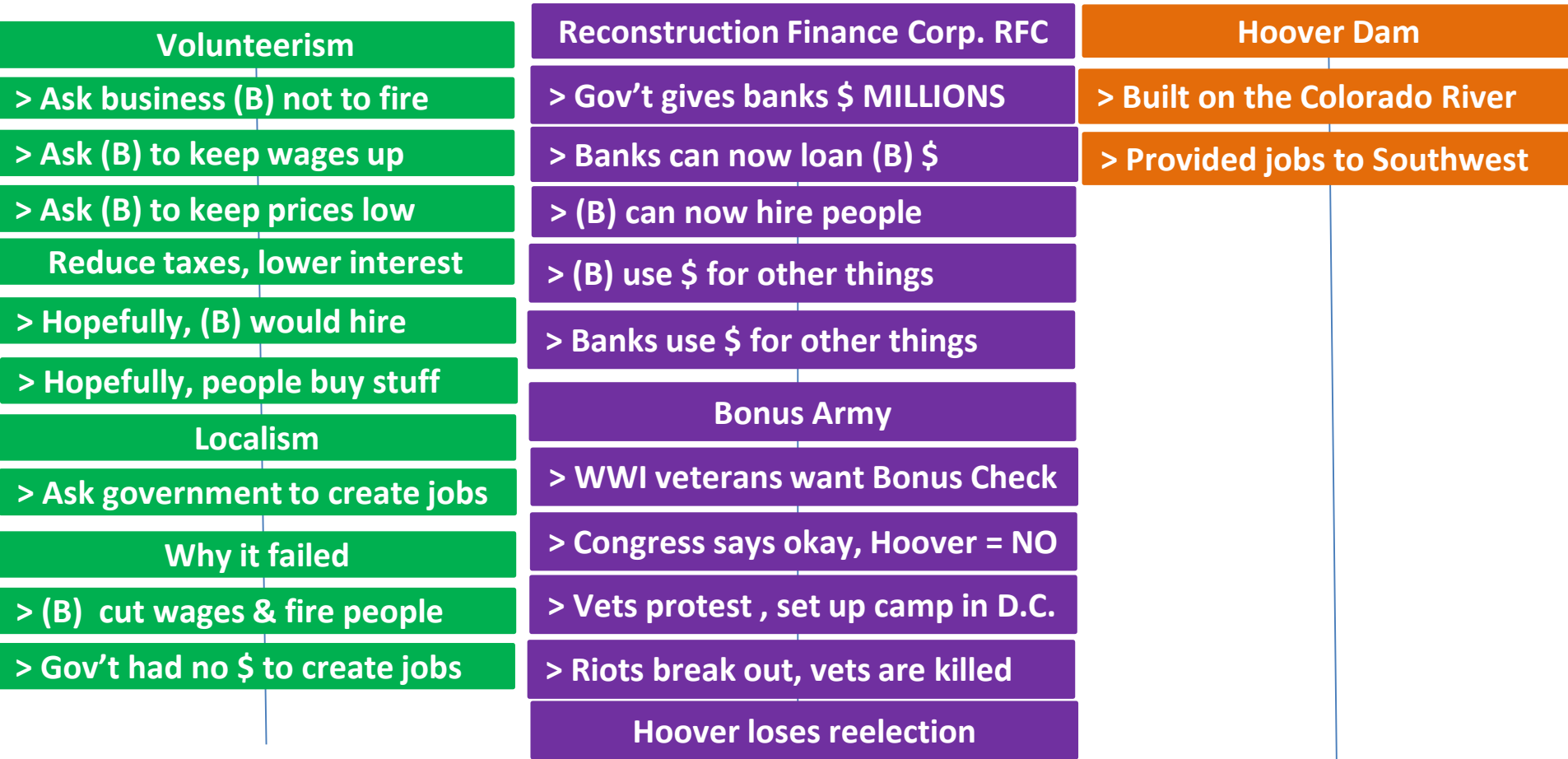

1921 - 1929 unemployment 3.7%	Farmers hurting = low crop prices	Hit hardest
1933 25% out of work	Soil dies aka Dust Bowl (DB)	African Americans
Families ran out of \$	> Cause - droughts & over farming	> 1932 50% out of work
> Sold all they owned to live	> Soil turns to dust	Mexican Americans (MA)
Breadlines	> Created huge dust storms	> Whites want (MA) deported
> People lines up for handouts	> (DB) located in OK, KS, NM & CO	> Want to (MA) sent to Mexico
> Run by charities	Many lost their farms	> This is called repatriation
Hoovervilles	> Become tenant farmer/slaves	
> Named after the President	Many farmers move to California	
> People evicted from homes	> (DB) migrants aka OKIES	
> Lived in shacks		
Cities	Rural	Minorities

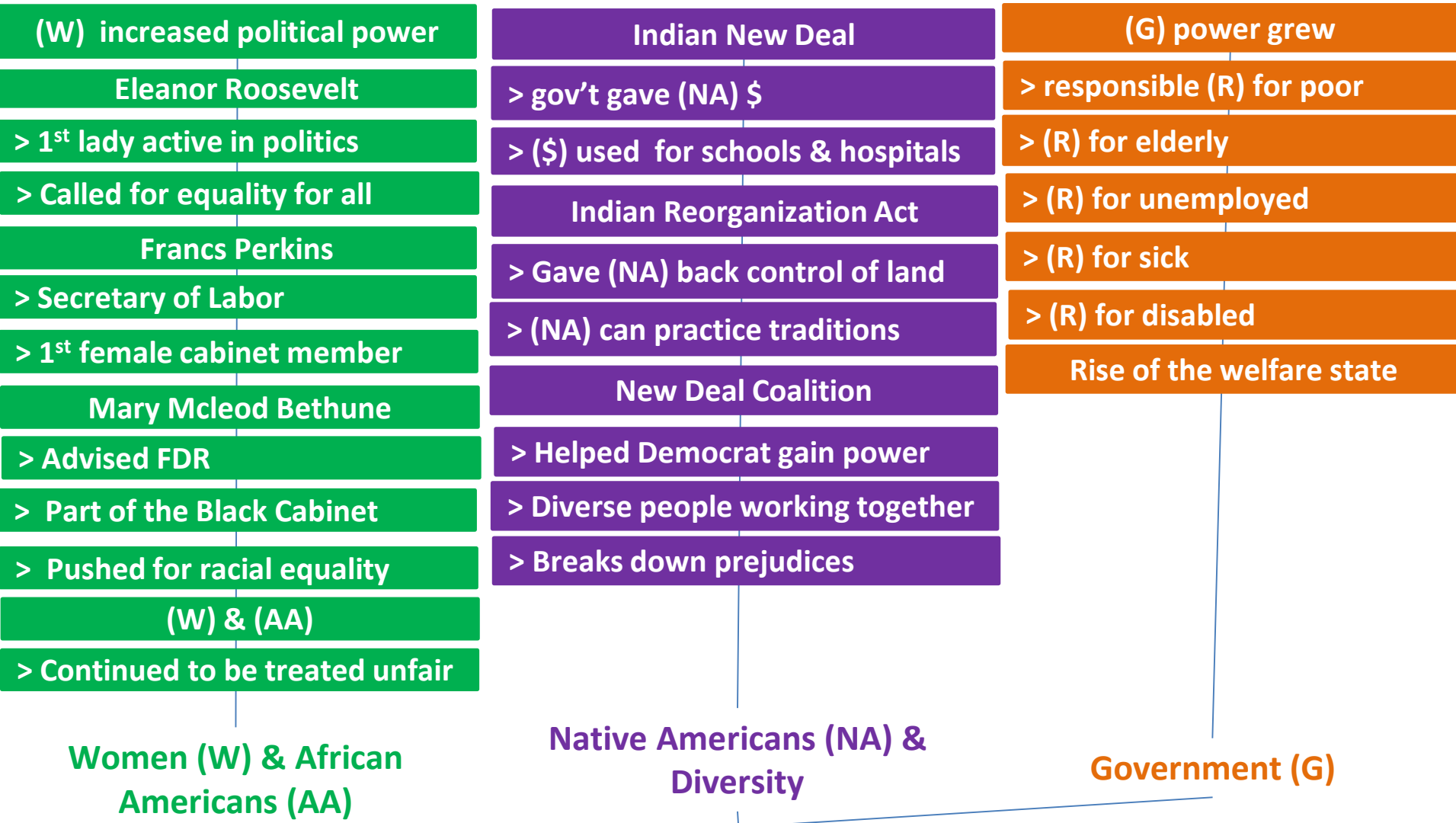

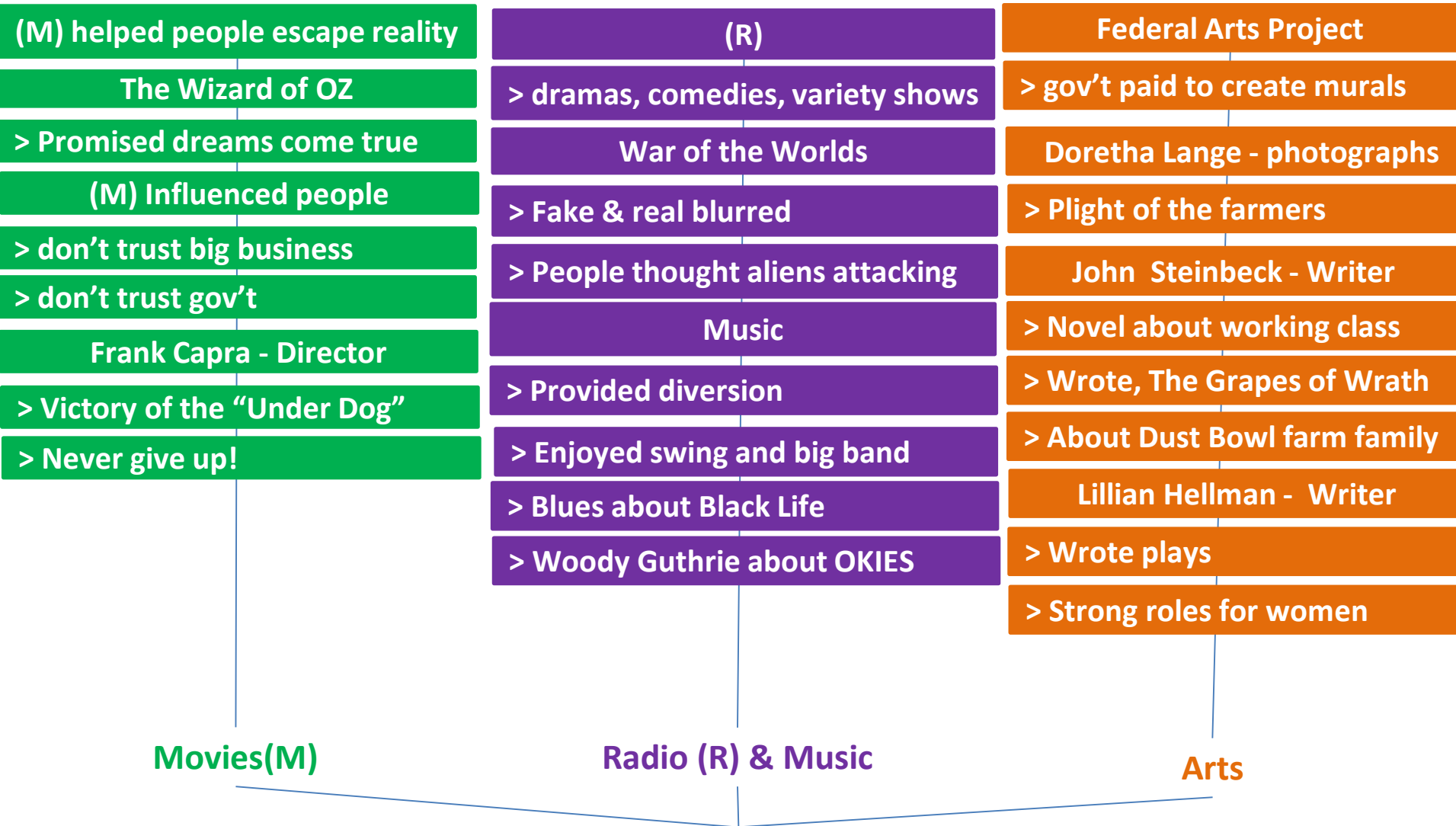
